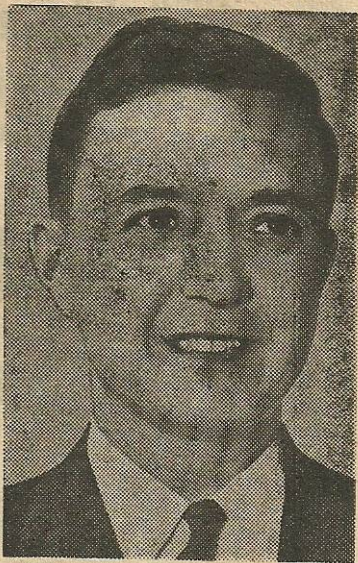


Gets Special Pay For War Heroism

Rodney Dove, former Royal Navy lieutenant, will receive \$700 back pay from the navy for the time he was held prisoner by the Nazis in World II but he says he feels guilty about accepting it. The special pay is being given to him for his part in blowing up ships at Palermo, Italy. He rode a midget submarine into Palermo harbor, attached magnetic explosive charges to the hull of a cruiser and watched it blow up. Captured, he spent over two years in a prison camp. He now lives in Vancouver.
